Module #11: Caregiver Neglect

Intended Audience

This course is designed for new APS social workers as well as Aging & Adult Service partners (e.g. APS/IHSS, IHSS and mental health). This training is also appropriate for senior staff that require knowledge and/or skills review.

Learning Objectives

- 1) Identify 3 physical and 3 behavioral indicators of caregiver neglect.
- 2) Identify 5 factors that contribute to victim risk of neglect.
- 3) Assess allegations of caregiver neglect using 5 domains of assessment.
- 4) Describe the barriers to determining if neglect is intentional or unintentional.
- 5) Identify 3 best practices in interviewing perpetrators.
- 6) Define 3 components of service planning.

Causes of Caregiver Neglect

- Cultural/social aspects of caregiver neglect
- ➤ Individual causes of caregiver neglect (burden of care, co-dependency, caregivers with mental illness, physical impairments or substance abuse)
