Revised Service Code Definitions:

Intensive Care Coordination (ICC SC 82) and Intensive Home Based Services (IHBS SC 83)

Please see attached new service code definitions for ICC and IHBS.

The ICC service code definition has been revised to include children/youth with a significant and complex functional impairment **and/or** whose treatment requires cross-agency collaboration. Any child/youth that has cross-agency collaboration (i.e. CWS, Probation, Education, Regional Center, etc.) is eligible for ICC, including youth that are identified as Enhanced/Subclass, Class, or non-CWS involved children/youth. A **Child and Family Team must be identified and documented** in order to provide ICC and IHBS. IHBS continues to be available to clients who are receiving ICC.
