 - Check and replenish SchooLink posters and brochures periodically.

Did you know there is a new California law (AB2022), effective January 1, 2019, that requires the education system to inform pupils and parents/guardians on how to initiate access to available pupil mental health services on campus or in the community? SchooLink and school staff may use the SchooLink posters and brochures to fulfill this requirement and increase awareness about SchooLink services.

The SchooLink **poster** details the pathways to youth behavioral services in San Diego County. The SchooLink **brochure** provides standardized, simple language on services and eligibility and is customizable for each school and SchooLink provider.
