

# Supervisor Core 3C: Onboarding New Staff

## Virtual Training



In this interactive and dynamic introductory training, participants learn about the onboarding process and the supervisor's role, implementing an onboarding plan, using training resources, encouraging critical thinking skills, and evaluating and documenting progress and providing effective feedback.

### Learning Objectives:

By the end of this training, participants will be able to:

- Define the onboarding process and its importance.
- Describe the supervisor's role during onboarding and 3 key components of the process.
- Evaluate and document new staff's progress in meeting milestones.

### Course Requirements:

Onboarding New Staff is a training program that is part of the National APS Supervisor Core Curriculum. It is one of four training modules that will be offered consecutively this fiscal year focused on supporting the core competency in Teambuilding and Individual Development.
